Six Hundred (600) million shillings</i></p> <p><i>The regulator set the above-mentioned amount as a minimum requirement, as a Procuring Entity (PE), Mombasa Water Supply and Sanitation Co. Ltd, the amount set as a requirement for paid-up capital of KES700Million is not prohibitive, neither does it serve to lock out some bidders from participating in this tender.</i></p> <p><i>We SHALL therefore consider evaluating the subject requirement MR16 using the minimum capital requirement of KES600Million as set out by Insurance Regulatory Authority (IRA).</i></p> |

This requirement will remain as it is in the bidding document.</i></p> |
